Bursary for Women entering a training program for a skilled trade

Award is planned to be distributed by Cambrian College for four years, supported by the Giving Plan, with one recipient per year.

Award Name

CFUW- Women going into Trades Bursary

Award Eligibility

Available to high school girls planning to enter a training program for a skilled trade or women entering a program after working. Examples of trade areas eligible for the CFUW-Women going into trades Bursary are listed in the attached list. However, if an applicant is entering a program for an area not listed, they may describe why they are eligible in their cover letter.

Award Criteria

- Acceptance into a training program at an accredited post-secondary institution
- Financial need
- The applicant has a GPA of at least 2.5
- One signed letter of reference from a school staff member who knows the applicant well, for high school girls. Or a letter of reference from an employer or a trades professional, who knows the applicant well, for women re-entering training.
- A desire to enter a skilled trade

Award Value

- \$1000.00

Application/Selection Process

Applicants are required to submit by midnight April 1 of the current year:

- A completed application form
- Cover letter describing why they are a suitable applicant for this bursary, e.g. why they wish to enter the training program they are applying for
- Letter of acceptance into a training program at a post-secondary institution
- Financial Statement as listed on the application form
- An official transcript of marks from grade 9 to the end of the first semester of grade 12, for high school applicants. A transcript of marks from the last school attended by women who have worked, now entering a training program.

- Letter of reference from a school staff member or trades professional or employer
- Recipient will be selected by the CFUW Awards Committee by the May meeting of the current year

Award Presentation

The CFUW Awards Committee will notify the successful recipient and other applicants of their decision in writing.
